Evaluation criteria for the admission exam to the PhD programme in Biochemistry (40th cycle)

The oral exam will be evaluated according to the following assessment grid:

Oral Exam (max 60 points)

During the oral exam, aspects regarding the submitted qualifications, the written paper will be explored and clarified, with points distributed as follows:

- Discussion of the paper and the candidate's qualifications: clarity of presentation, ability to synthesize, and scientific interest of the CV (10 points);
- Verification of the candidate's general scientific culture and his/her aptitude to tackle laboratory research from both a theoretical and methodological point of view, evaluating clarity, mastery and specific competence (40 points);
- Foreign language (10 points).

Candidates who score at least 40/60 points in the evaluation will pass the oral exam

The minimum overall score for admission to the PhD programme is 82/125
