

ASSESSMENT CRITERIA FOR THE ADMISSION EXAM TO THE DOCTORATE COURSE IN HUMAN BIOLOGY AND MEDICAL GENETICS

The evaluation will be carried out based on the results of the exam tests.
The presentation of titles is not required.

Written test

The written test consists in the development of a paper concerning topics related to cellular and molecular biology, general and medical genetics. The required degree of knowledge is that of a specialist degree.

Up to 60 points can be attributed to the written work.

The scores will be distributed as follows:

- Knowledge and competence on the test topic (20 points)
- Ability and clarity drafting (20 points)
- Comprehensiveness and recent acquisitions on the test topic (20 points).

The test is passed with a minimum score of 40/60.

Oral exam

During the oral exam, aspects concerning the written test, previous research experiences, especially the subject of the master's degree thesis, and the project will be deepened and clarified.

Up to 60 points can be attributed to the interview.

The scores will be distributed as follows:

- Discussion on the written test and on topics related to the master's degree thesis (and / or other experiences) (25 points)
- Project autonomy (20 points)
- Knowledge and ability to use specific techniques (10 points)
- Foreign language (5 points).

The test is passed with a minimum score of 40/60.

The overall minimum score for admission to the PhD is 80/120
