

## **Evaluation criteria for the admission to the PhD course in “ARCHAEOLOGY” (40th cycle)**

Candidates who obtained at least 40/60 in the written test are admitted to the oral exam. The oral exam will be evaluated according to the following assessment grid:

### **Oral exam (max 60 points)**

During the oral exam, aspects relating to the submitted qualifications, the written test and the research project will be examined and clarified, as well as disciplinary knowledge relating to the chosen curriculum. The marks will be distributed as follows:

- Discussion of the written paper (points 0–15);
- Verification of disciplinary knowledge of the chosen curriculum (points 0-15);
- Discussion on the research project (points 0-25);
- Foreign language test (0-5 points).

**Candidates who score at least 40/60 points in the evaluation will pass the oral exam**

**The minimum overall score for admission to the PhD programme is 120/180**
