2. Project (max 30 points)

In the research project, the candidate must demonstrate clear abilities to design, organize and develop the scientific research in total autonomy. The full text must not exceed 5 pages (excluding the references). This project, which must be submitted by candidates in order to take part to the call, and will not be considered compulsory for the research activity of winner participants.

The project will be evaluated on the following points:

- Knowledge of the state of the art (5 points)
- Innovative aspects of the project (5 points)
- Clarity and completeness of the specific objectives, research strategy, attainability (10 points)
- Feasibility of the project (5 points)
- Relevance of the project to the educational goals of the PhD program (5 points).

The minimum score valid for the CV, professional titles + Research project in order to get shortlisted for the interview is 35/50.

3. Interview (max 70 points)

The oral interview will be based on the following scheme:

- Discussion about the research project: (max 40 points)
- Discussion about written text exam and curriculum: capability in summarize the central points and academic qualifications (max 20 points)

• Foreign language (max 10 points)

The minimum score valid to pass the interview is 50/70.

The overall minimum score for admission to the research doctorate is 85/120.
