

Evaluation criteria for the admission exam to the PhD in “Advances in infectious diseases, microbiology, legal medicine and public health sciences”

(40 cycle)

CV, project and oral test will be evaluated according to the following evaluation grid.

1. CV (max 15 points)

1.1 Graduation grade (– max 7 points)

1.3 Research experience (max 3 points)

Experience abroad (a least 2 months, Erasmus included)	1,5

2. Project (max 60 points)

For the PhD selection, the candidate must present a project that will allow the commission to evaluate his ability to carry out research activities and his ability to project and organize independently the steps of a project. The project should not exceed 8000 characters (excluding the reference section).

Evaluation points:

Knowledge of the state of the art (10 points)

Originality and innovative content (10 points)

Description of the objectives, methodologies and potential results (10 points)

Project feasibility (10 points)

Pertinence of the project with the PhD training objectives (20 points)

3. Oral test (max 45 punti)

Candidates with a score of minimum 50/75 are admitted to the oral interview. This will be focused on aspects concerning the project and the CV presented. The minimum positive score for the oral test is 30/45.

The minimum global score needed to be admitted to the PhD is 80/120.
