## **Evaluation criteria for the admission exam to the PhD programme in Engineering and Applied Science for Energy and Industry (40th cycle)**

## Oral Exam (max 60 points)

The minimum score (obtained summing the score of qualifications and of the research proposal) for the admission to the oral exam is 40/60. During the oral exam, aspects regarding the submitted qualifications, the written research proposal will be explored and clarified, with points distributed as follows:

Discussion of topics related to the research project (40 points);

Discussion of the paper and the candidate's qualifications: clarity of presentation, ability to synthesize, and scientific interest of the CV (10 points);

Foreign language (10 points).

Minimum score valid 40/60

The minimum overall score for admission to the PhD programme is 80/120
