

## Evaluation criteria for the admission text to PhD in Archaeology (38th cycle)

Qualifications, project and oral exam will be evaluated according to the following evaluation grid:

### 1. Titles (max 15 points)

#### 1.1. Final grade (master degree – max 5 points)

Students who will discuss the thesis before the date of the qualifications must be communicate to the coordinator of the course or the President of the Commission their final grade. For students who discuss the thesis after the date of the qualifications, but before 31 October 2022, the grid in point 1.1 is replaced by the following:

The total will be divided by the number of years or fractions of a year between the date of the master's degree.

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2. **Project** (max 45 points)

For the selection, each candidate must submit a project that assess propensity for research, ability to organize different phases of the project. The project must not exceed the maximum length of 12,000 characters (notes and spaces included), plus the bibliography. In particular, will be evaluated:

Quality and originality (15 points)

Position in the national and international scientific framework (10 points)

Project feasibility (10 points)

Relevance of the project with the chosen curriculum (10 points)

The evaluation of titles and project is binding for the admission to the written test. Candidates who obtained less than 40/60 points will not be admitted to the written test.

3. **Written test** (max 60 points)

Clarity and completeness (points 0–15)

Correspondence with the theme (points 0–15)

Knowledge of the national and international bibliography (points 0–15)

Ability to organize the paper (0-15 points).

Candidates who in the written test have at least of 40/60 points are admitted to the oral test.

4. **Oral test** (max 60 points)

discussion of the written paper (points 0–15); verification of disciplinary knowledge of the chosen curriculum (points 0-15);

discussion on the project (points 0-25);

foreign language test (0-5 points).

To pass the test, the candidate must have at least 40/60 points.
