

EVALUATION CRITERIA FOR THE PH.D in

PRIVATE AUTONOMY BUSINESS, WORK AND PROTECTION OF RIGHTS IN EUROPEAN AND INTERNATIONAL PERSPECTIVE

(40° cycle)

1) Written Exam (min 40 points - max 60 points)

Evaluation criteria for the written exam:

- grammatical correctness and syntax: **max 10 points (sufficiency: 7 points);**
- clarity: **max 10 points (sufficiency: 7 points);**
- complete, coherent and orderly development of argumentation: **max 10 points (sufficiency: 7 points);**
- problematic analysis of the arguments: **max 10 points (sufficiency: 7 points);**
- knowledge of the doctrinal and jurisprudential debate: **max 10 points (sufficiency: 6 points);**
- historical and comparative framework: **max 10 points (sufficiency: 6 points).**

They are admitted to the oral examination the candidates who have passed the written exam with a minimum score of 40/60 points and who have reached sufficiency to every criterion of evaluation.

2) Oral Examination (min 40 points - max 60 points)

Evaluation criteria for the oral exam:

- aptitude for research and study motivation: **max 15 points (sufficiency: 10 points);**
- argumentative capacity and problematic approach: **max 15 points (sufficiency: 10 points);**
- good knowledge of curriculum subjects: **max 15 points (sufficiency: 10 points);**
- correctness and clarity: **max 15 points (sufficiency: 10 points);**

The oral exam is passed if the candidate gets a minimum score of 40/60 points and eaches sufficiency to every criterion of evaluation.

3) Qualifications (max 15 points)

For the final ranking 15 points can be attributed on the basis of the qualifications enclosed:
