Evaluation criteria for the admission to the PhD programme in Mathematical Models for Engineering, Electromagnetism and Nanoscience (40th cycle)

Titles (max 60 points)

The titles will be evaluated on the basis of the following evaluation grid.

- Curriculum Vitae et Studiorum: up to 36 points. The Committee will evaluate the Curriculum (marks, exams taken, publications, scholarships and contracts, seminars, other activities), paying specific attention to the relevance with respect to the Course's research fields.
- Recommendation letters by experts not belonging to the Scientific Board
 ("Collegio dei docenti") of the PhD course: up to 16 points. The Committee will
 evaluate content and motivations of the assessments, paying specific attention to
 the relevance with respect to the Course's research fields.
- **Motivation letter** by the candidate: up to **8** points. The Committee will evaluate motivations and research programs, paying specific attention to the relevance with respect to the Course's research fields.

Candidates who have obtained at least 31 points in the overall assessment of qualifications are eligible for the next test.
