

Evaluation criteria for the admission exam to the PhD in Theoretical and Applied Mechanics 37th cycle PON

Oral exam (max 60 points)

The oral exam includes aspects concerning the theoretical and applied mechanics in general, and more specifically referred to the subject of the call.

The given scores follow the scheme ahead:

- Discussion on the general themes of theoretical and applied mechanics (30 points);
- Discussion on the topics of specific interest for the call (30 points).

The test is positive with a minimum score of 40/60, which also represents the minimum score for the admission to the doctorate
