

# **Evaluation criteria for the written test for the entrance exam to the PhD in Behavioural Neuroscience (40th cycle)**

The written test will be evaluated according to the following evaluation grid:

Written test (max 30 points)

For the purposes of selection for the research doctorate, the candidate must demonstrate that they are able to develop a research project on one of the 4 topics proposed during the exam. In particular, the following will be evaluated:

- Ability to theoretical framework with respect to the state of the art (5 points)
- Clarity and completeness of the experimental hypotheses (10 points)
- Ability to process methodological aspects and data analysis (10 points)
- Ability to elaborate and complete the presentation of possible results and their theoretical framework (5 points).

The test is considered passed with a minimum score of 16/30.
