

Evaluation criteria for the admission exam to the PhD programme in Genetics and Molecular Biology (40th cycle)

The oral exam will be evaluated according to the following assessment grid:

Oral Exam (max 40 points)

During the oral exam, aspects regarding the submitted qualifications, the written paper and/or the project proposal will be explored and clarified, with points distributed as follows:

- Discussion of topics related to the research project (30 points);
In the research project, the candidate must demonstrate clear abilities to design, organize and develop the scientific research in total autonomy.
In particular, there will be evaluated:
 - Innovative aspects of the project (5 points)
 - Clarity and completeness of the presentation of objectives, methodologies, and potential results (10 points)
 - Feasibility of the project (5 points)
 - Relevance of the project to the educational objectives of the PhD programme (10 points)
- Evaluation of the candidate's knowledge in topics related to genetics and molecular biology (10 points)

The minimum overall score for admission to the PhD programme is 25/120
