Evaluation criteria for the admission to the PhD program in Engineering-based Architecture and Urban Planning 40th cycle - Oral examination

Oral examination (max 60 points)

Candidates admitted to the oral examination will have obtained a score of at least 40/60 in the evaluation of the qualifications, of the statement of purpose and of the research project combined together.

During the oral examination, some aspects regarding the qualifications and the research project presented will be further explored and clarified. The scores will be assigned as follows:

- discussion on the research project main topics (40 points)
- clarity of exposition, ability to synthesize and scientific interest in the curriculum (15 points)
- foreign language (5 points)

The oral examination is considered passed with a score of at least 40/60.

The minimum overall score for the admission to the PhD program is 80/120.
