Evaluation criteria for the admission exam to the PhD programme in Computer Science (40th cycle)

The oral exam will be evaluated according to the following assessment grid:

Oral Exam (max 60 points)

The interview will cover topics related to the candidate's CV, motivations, research project, and dissertation abstract, and will include questions of basic computer science knowledge where these are related to the candidate's research interests. The outcome of the interview is quantified as a score between 0 and 60.

Candidates who score at least 30/60 points in the evaluation will pass the oral exam.

The minimum overall score for admission to the PhD programme is 85/140.
