

Evaluation criteria for the admission to the PhD programme in Physics (40th cycle)

Titles (max 24 points)

Grades of bachelor's degree exams and grade of bachelor's degree (maximum 12 points)

The weighted average of grades obtained on exams will be evaluated according to the following table (8 points maximum):

weighted average of grades = X	Points
$29 < X \leq 30$	8
$28 < X \leq 29$	6
$27 < X \leq 28$	5
$26 < X \leq 27$	4
$25 < X \leq 26$	3
$X \leq 25$	2

The grade of the bachelor's degree will be evaluated according to the following table (4 points maximum):

Bachelor's degree grade = X	Points
110 e lode	4
$109 < X \leq 110$	3
$107 < X \leq 109$	2,5
$105 < X \leq 107$	2
$103 < X \leq 105$	1,5
$X \leq 103$	1

Grading of master's degree exams (maximum 12 points)

The weighted average of grades obtained on exams according to the following table will be evaluated:

weighted average of grades = X	Points
$29 < X \leq 30$	12

$28 < X \leq 29$	10
$27 < X \leq 28$	9
$26 < X \leq 27$	8
$X \leq 26$	7

For the candidates who graduated in a foreign country, the grades will be converted to the Italian scale before being evaluated.

Candidates who score at least 16 points in the evaluation of qualifications are admitted to the oral interview.
