

**Evaluation criteria for the admission exam to the PhD in Philology and History  
of the Ancient World (40th cycle)**

The written test will be assessed according to the following evaluation grid:

Written test (max 55 points)

In particular, the following will be assessed

- Knowledge and competence of the subject matter of the test (20 points)
- Ability and clarity of presentation (15 points)
- Descriptive thoroughness and recent acquisitions on the subject of the test (20 points)

Candidates scoring at least 35 points in the written test will be admitted to the next test.
