

Evaluation criteria for the admission to the PhD course “Theoretical and Applied Mechanics” 36th cycle

The written and the oral tests will be evaluated according to the following evaluation grid:

1. Written test (max 60 points)

Knowledge and expertise about the subject matter of the test (20 points) Capability and clarity in the elaboration (20 points) Descriptive completeness and recent acquisitions about the subject matter of the test (20 points). The written test is passed if the candidate obtained at least 40/60.

2. Oral Test (max 60 points)

Candidate who obtained at least 40/60 in the evaluation of the written test are admitted to the oral. During the oral test will be examined and clarified the side relative to the written test and theme of general interest in the field of applied mechanics. The oral test is passed if the candidate obtained at least 40/60. The minimum overall score to be admitted is 80/120.
