

**Evaluation criteria for the admission to the PhD course  
“PSYCHOPATHOLOGY AND MENTAL FUNCTIONING: RESEARCH  
METHODS IN FORENSIC” 40th cycle**

The oral exam will be evaluated according to the following assessment grid:

**Oral exam (max 35 points)**

To be admitted to the oral examination, candidates must obtain a mark of at least 35/50 on their research project. The oral exam will involve the following aspects:

Discussion about the research project (20 points);

Discussion about the curriculum and the research's interest: capability in summarize the central points and academic qualifications (max 5 points);

English language (max 10 points).

The English language assessment might involve discussing the research project or translating a written text.

**The minimum score to obtain for the oral exam is 25/35.**

**The minimum final resulting score valid for the admission is 60/100.**
