The titles will be evaluated on the basis of the following evaluation grid:

Evaluation of Laurea degrees (max 30 points)

Evaluation of Laurea degrees

- minimum points for the admission to the oral exam: 15
- maximum points: 30

Evaluation of Laurea degrees will be done according to the following tables for the first and second level:

- first level Laurea final mark: max 18 points.
- average of marks for exams of second level Laurea degree: max 12 points.
