

Evaluation criteria for the admission to the PhD course “International, comparative, and public Law” 39th cycle

Written test (max 60 points)

Comprehensibility and clarity (up to 20 points)

Coherence and accuracy of script (up to 20 points)

Quality of critical arguments (up to 20 points).

Interview (max 60 points)

Candidates who received a mark at least 40/60 in the written test are admitted to the interview.

Sharp and updated knowledge of the main topics of the selected curriculum (max 20 points);

Assessment of scientific interests and motivation (max 15 points)

Correctness of speech (max 20 points)

Foreign language (max 5 points).

Minimum score valid 40/60
