CRITERIA FOR THE EVALUATION OF QUALIFICATIONS

A) **research project**, as indicated below, up to 25 points

B) **curriculum vitae, university grades, language skills and other qualifications**, up to 10 points,
of which::

1) University final degree mark (max 3 points)

Students who will defend their thesis before the date established for the evaluation of qualifications are required to communicate to the PhD Programme Coordinator or to the President of the Commission the grade obtained in their degree, while for those who will defend the thesis after the date established for the evaluation of qualifications, but before October 31, 2024, the grid in point 1 is replaced by the following:

- 2) 1 point for a specialization degree or Ph.D., 1 point for other university degrees (excluding the three-year degree), 1 point for II level University Master Course or secondary school teaching qualification, 0.5 points for three-year degree, 0.5 points for II level University Master Course, provided that they are relevant and **up to a maximum of 4 points total**;
- 3) other qualifications, **up to a maximum of 3 points total**: 0.5 points for certified knowledge in each foreign language beyond the elementary/beginner level, corresponding at least to level B1; from 0.2 to 1 point for each other title relevant for the selection (e.g. participation in research projects, scholarships, research grant, etc.), depending on the importance and duration.



C) scientific publications, if any, up to 5 points, of which;

da 0 a 5 points for relevant publications, with 1 point for each scientific publication and 0.2 points for each other publication (information articles, reviews, etc., up to a maximum of 5, i.e. 1 point total); the score is halved for shared publications where the candidate's contribution is not specified.

Criteria of the Research Project

The research project, with a maximum length of 25,000 characters including spaces (but excluding the bibliography), should specify the following points:

- 1) Objectives and purposes;
- 2) State of the art;
- 3) Methodology and tools;
- 4) Program (with time frame and possible collaborations with national and international research institutes);
- 5) Expected results;
- 6) Bibliographical references.

The evaluation criteria are:

- 1) relevance to the Ph.D. subject areas;
- 2) importance and originality of the expected results;
- 3) mastery of disciplinary and methodological competences relevant to the research;
- 4) information about the state of knowledge regarding the research topic and the most relevant literature;
- 5) clarity and effectiveness in the presentation of the objectives and in the indication of the approach and the steps of the research;
- 6) feasibility of the project, congruence between objectives, skills, tools and time available;
- 7) new elements of the research project with respect to the subject of the master thesis (or equivalent).

To be admitted to the interview, the minimum score required for the titles is 26/40.

Criteria for the interview

The interview, in Italian (and, for the Russian curriculum, also in Russian), is aimed to verifying the candidate's preparation, skills and attitudes in the scientific areas of the chosen curriculum and with specific reference to the research project proposed.

The minimum score for a positive evaluation is 40/60.
