

Evaluation criteria for admission to the 40th cycle of PhD in Electrical, Materials and Nanotechnology Engineering

1. Oral exam (max 50 points)

Only candidates who will collect at least 30/50 points throughout the assessment of titles, motivational letter and research project, will be admitted to the oral exam.

The oral exam aims to assess the background of expertise and skills of the candidate and his/her research attitude with reference to the topics of the PhD programme.

In particular, the following aspects will be addressed by the Selection Board: qualification of the candidate, motivations for pursuing the specific PhD programme, research project submitted by the applicant and knowledge of English language.

The interview can be conducted also remotely, to allow applicants living abroad to take part in the admission process: the request must be presented at the application stage and in any case no later than 15 days before the date of the interview.

The oral exam is successful if the candidate reaches at least 30/50 points.

Only those candidates who will collect a minimum score of 60/100 are eligible for the admission to the PhD programme.
