

## **History of Europe – Evaluation Criteria XXXV Cycle**

The first selection will be based on the assessment of candidates' qualification and documentation presented by each candidate.

The selected candidates will be admitted to the interview (or oral exam).

### **A) Scores for CV and Research Project (max 60 points)**

1. Master Degree Final Mark – (max 5 points)
2. Research Project (max 40 points)
3. Publications (max 5 points)
4. Languages (max 5 points)
5. Other (max 5 points)

**A minimum score of 40/60 is required to be admitted to the colloquium.**

The degree mark is evaluated as follows:

**The research project is evaluated as follows:**

Knowledge of the state-of-the-art (max 8 points)

Originality and innovative content (max 8 points)

Clarity and thoroughness of the exposure of objectives, methodologies and potential results (max 8 points)

Feasibility of the project (max 8 points)

Consistency with the PhD. program objectives (max 8 points)

**B. Interview (max 60 points)**

a) Clarity of the presentation and knowledge of the topics (max 60 points)

**The test is passed with a minimum score of 40/60**

**The minimum score for admission to the PhD. is 80/120**
