TO THE PHD COURSE "PHILOSOPHY"
40TH CYCLE**

The titles will be evaluated on the basis of the following evaluation grid:

Titles (max 75 points)

2. Publications (max 7 points)

3. Research experiences (max 3 points)

4. Abstract Master's thesis (max 10 points)

The abstract of the master's (or equivalent) degree thesis work must have a length between 4000 and 6000 characters (spaces and any bibliographic references included). The evaluation will consider in particular the clarity of the exposition and the objectives.

5. Research project (max 50 points)

In the research project, the candidate must demonstrate clear abilities to design, organize and develop the scientific research in total autonomy. The full text, which must include a bibliography of up to 10 titles, must have a minimum length of 6000 characters and a maximum length of 10000 (including spaces). This project, which must be submitted by candidates in order to take part to the call, will not be considered compulsory for the research activity of winner participants. Scores will be distributed as follows:

- Knowledge of the state of the art (10 points)
- Innovative aspects of the project (10 points)
- Clarity and completeness of the specific objectives, research strategy, attainability (10 points)
- Feasibility of the project (10 points)
- Relevance of the project to the educational goals of the PhD program (10 points)

Minimum score valid 50/75
