Evaluation criteria for the admission to the PhD programme in Chemical Sciences 40th cycle

The oral exam will be evaluated according to the following assessment grid:

Oral Exam (max 50 points)

- minimum points for the eligibility in the final admission list: 25
- maximum points: 50

The oral exam is aimed at verifying the candidate's aptitude for scientific research and his general preparation in relation to the PhD in Chemical Sciences.

This test will focus on the research topics related to each PhD fellowship and on general chemistry topics.

The knowledge of the English language will be assessed during the oral exam.

The minimum overall score for the admission to the PhD course in Chemical Sciences is 50/100.
