

Evaluation criteria for the admission exam to the PhD programme in History Anthropology Religions (40th cycle)

The oral exam will be evaluated according to the following assessment grid:

Oral Exam (max 60 points)

During the oral exam, aspects regarding the submitted qualifications, the written paper and/or the project proposal will be explored and clarified, with points distributed as follows:

- Discussion of topics related to the research project (50 points);
- Foreign language (10 points).

Candidates who score at least 40/60 points in the evaluation will pass the oral exam

The minimum overall score for admission to the PhD programme is 80/120
