

Evaluation criteria for admission "Mathematical Models for Engineering, Electromagnetism and Nanoscience "

The final ranking will be drawn up on the basis of the two tests, the evaluation of qualifications and the oral test. The maximum score for each test is 60 points

Valuation of the qualifications

- Curriculum Vitae et Studiorum: maximum 25 points; the commission will evaluate the candidate's qualifications and the type of degree most relevant to the specific project.
- Publications: maximum 15 points; only products relevant to the specific project will be evaluated.
- Letters of introduction from experts not belonging to the Board of Professors of the Doctorate: maximum 20 points; the content and motivations of the judgments provided will be evaluated.

Evaluation of the Oral Exam

- Consistency of the candidate's scientific interests and motivations consistent with the project: 25 points
- Candidate specific technical competence: 35 points
