

Evaluation criteria for the admission exam to the PhD programme in Mathematical Models for Engineering, Electromagnetism and Nanoscience (40th cycle)

Oral Exam (max 60 points)

The oral exam will be evaluated according to the following assessment grid.

- Education, competences, research interests and goals, paying specific attention to the relevance with respect to the Course's research fields: up to **45** points.
- Clarity, synthesis skills, and framing skills: up to **15** points.

Candidates who score at least 31 points in the evaluation will pass the oral exam.

The minimum overall score for admission to the PhD programme is 62/120.
