

Evaluation grid for the admission exam to the PhD course “Theoretical and Applied Mechanics”

39th cycle

Written and oral exams will be evaluated according to the following grid:

Written exam (max 60 points)

Knowledge and expertise of the reported argument (20 points)

Competence and clarity in the elaboration (20 points)

Descriptive completeness also on recent advances on the subject (20 points).

Those candidates obtaining at least 40/60 points in the evaluation of written exam are admitted to the oral exam.

Oral exam (max 60 points)

During the oral exam the written document is examined in detail to clarify concepts expressed by each candidate in relation to typical theories and methods employed in applied mechanics.

The oral exam is passed if the candidate obtained at least 40/60 points.

The minimum overall score to be classified is 80/120 points.
