

Evaluation criteria for the admission exam to the PhD programme in PSYCHOLOGY AND SOCIAL NEUROSCIENCE (40th cycle)

The oral exam will be evaluated according to the following assessment grid:

Oral Exam (max 70 points)

During the oral exam, aspects regarding the submitted qualifications and the project proposal will be explored and clarified, with points distributed as follows:

- Discussion of topics related to the research project (40 points);
- Discussion of the candidate's qualifications: clarity of presentation, ability to synthesize, and scientific interest of the CV (20 points);
- Foreign language (10 points).

The minimum score valid to pass the interview is 50/70.

The overall minimum score for admission to the research doctorate is 85/120.
