

## **Evaluation criteria for the admission exam to the PhD programme in Translational Medicine and Oncology (40th cycle)**

The oral exam will be evaluated according to the following assessment grid:

### **Oral Exam (max 60 points)**

During the oral exam, aspects regarding the submitted qualifications, the written paper and/or the project proposal will be explored and clarified, with points distributed as follows:

- Discussion of topics related to the research project (40 points);
- Discussion of the paper and the candidate's qualifications: clarity of presentation, ability to synthesize, and scientific interest of the CV (10 points);
- Foreign language (10 points).

**Candidates who score at least 40. points in the evaluation will pass the oral exam** (*to be specified only if a minimum score for passing the examination is required*)

**The minimum overall score for admission to the PhD programme is 120/180\*** (*to be specified only if a minimum score for admission is required to the PhD programme*).

**\*Note: The denominator for calculating the admission score to the PhD programme must be equal to the sum of the maximum scores of each individual test included in the competition.**

*For example: maximum qualifications score 60, maximum written test score 60, maximum oral test score 60 = the denominator for admission is 120./180.*
