Evaluation criteria for the admission exam to the PhD programme in Translational Medicine and Oncology (40th cycle)

The oral exam will be evaluated according to the following assessment grid:

Oral Exam (max 60 points)

During the oral exam, aspects regarding the submitted qualifications, the written paper and/or the project proposal will be explored and clarified, with points distributed as follows:

- Discussion of topics related to the research project (40 points);
- Discussion of the paper and the candidate's qualifications: clarity of presentation, ability to synthesize, and scientific interest of the CV (10 points);
- Foreign language (10 points).

Candidates who score at least 40. points in the evaluation will pass the oral exam (to be specified only if a minimum score for passing the examination is required)

The minimum overall score for admission to the PhD programme is 120/180* (to be specified only if a minimum score for admission is required to the PhD programme).

*Note: The denominator for calculating the admission score to the PhD programme must be equal to the sum of the maximum scores of each individual test included in the competition.

For example: maximum qualifications score 60, maximum written test score 60, maximum oral test score 60 = the denominator for admission is 120./180.
