Research project (max 45 points)

In the research project, the candidate must demonstrate clear abilities to design, organize and develop the scientific research in total autonomy. The full text must not exceed 8,000 signs (excluding spaces, separated bibliography). This project, which must be submitted by candidates in order to take part to the call, will not be considered compulsory for the research activity of winner participants.

The project will be evaluated on the basis of the following criteria:

Knowledge of the state of the art and innovative aspects (max 25 points)

Clarity and completeness of the specific objectives, research strategy, attainability, feasibility of the project (max 20 points)

Interview (max 60 points)

Minimum score valid for the admission to the Interview: 40/60.

The interview will be evaluated on the basis of the following criteria:

Discussion about the research project: (max 50 points);

Foreign language (max 10 points).

Minimum score valid 40/60.

Minimum valid score for admission to the PhD course: 120/180.
