## Evaluation grid for the admission to the PhD course in Civilizations of Asia and Africa, 40<sup>th</sup> cycle

## **EVALUATION OF THE ORAL EXAM (MAX 60 POINTS)**

Only candidates who have obtained at least 40/60 points in the evaluation of qualifications are admitted to the oral exam.

The oral test will be assessed according to the following evaluation grid:

- verification of the language skills (languages of Africa, Asia and/or Europe/America) considered essential for the research project (max 20 points);
- discussion of the research project, with verification of historical, literary, artistic, philosophical or historical-religious knowledge relating to the project (max 40 points).

Only candidates who have obtained at least 40 points (summing the verification of language skills and discussion of the project) pass the oral test.

The minimum overall mark for admission to the PhD programme is 80/120.
