4 – Research project (max 45 points)

In the research project, the candidate must demonstrate clear abilities to design, organize and develop the scientific research in total autonomy. The full text must not exceed 8,000 characters (including spaces). This project, which must be submitted the purposes of the competition, will not be considered compulsory for the research activity of winner participants.

In particular, there will be evaluated:

- Knowledge of the state of the art (10 points)
- Innovative aspects of the project (10 points)
- Clarity and completeness of the presentation of objectives, methodologies, and potential results (10 points)
- Feasibility of the project (10 points)
- Relevance of the project to the educational objectives of the PhD programme (5 points)

Candidates who have obtained at least 40/60 points in the overall assessment of qualifications are eligible for the next test.
