

## Evaluation criteria for the admission to the PhD course “International, Comparative and Public Law” 38th cycle

### 1. CV and professional titles (max 15 points)

#### 1.1. University final degree mark (max 5 points)

### **Research project (max 45 points)**

The proposal should be original. To be positively assessed the proposal should be articulates as follows: 1) Title; 2) State of the art (main trends and arguments in contemporary research on the subject chosen) (max 2000 characters, including spaces); 3) A detailed description of the project highlighting its originality in relation to the existing literature on the subject as well as the different research hypothesis, and, also, specifying the relevant stages in its development and completion (max 15000 characters, including spaces); 4) Selected bibliography (max 20 publications).

Consistency with the chosen curriculum of Phd Program (max 15 points)

Appropriate knowledge of the literature (max 5 points)

Originality and feasibility of the expected results (max 10 points)

Clarity and completeness of the specific objectives, methodology, and research hypothesis (15 points).

### **Interview (max 60 points)**

Candidates who receive a mark of the 40/60 in the first stage are eligible for the oral test. Knowledge in line with subjects of the chosen curriculum as well as research project will be assessed through the oral exam. Other languages indicated besides Italian will be also verified.

Knowledge of subjects consistent with the chosen curriculum of PhD Program (max 35 points);  
Ability in presentation and critical discussion on the main legal implications of the research project  
(max 15 points);  
Foreign language (max 10 points).

Minimum score valid 40/60

**The minimum final resulting score valid for the admission is 80/120**
