

Evaluation criteria for the admission exam to the PhD course in International, comparative and public law (40th cycle)

The oral exam will be evaluated according to the following assessment grid:

Oral Exam (max 60 points)

During the oral exam, aspects regarding the written paper, the subjects of the chosen curriculum and research fields will be explored and clarified, with points distributed as follows:

- Discussion of topics related to the chosen curriculum (20 points);
- Coherence and feasibility of scientific interests (15 points)
- Clarity of presentation, ability to synthesize, and appropriate communication (15 points);
- Foreign language (10 points).

Candidates who score at least 40 points in the evaluation will pass the oral exam

The minimum overall score for admission to the PhD programme is 80/120
