2. Project (max 30 points)

The project should not exceed the maximum length of 8000 characters (spaces included). For the project, it will be evaluated the aptitude to research of the candidate. It will also be evaluated the ability to autonomously organize the different sections of the project. The candidate will not be bound to the research activity outlined in the project if admitted to the PhD program.

In particular, the following will be evaluated:

Knowledge of the state of the art (5 points)

Originality and innovative content (10 points)

Clarity and completeness of the exposure of objectives, methodologies and potential results (5 points)

Project feasibility (5 points)

Relevance of the project for the objectives of the PhD in Data Science (5 points)

3. Oral test (max 60 points)

Candidates who have obtained a grade of at least 36/60 in the evaluation of the qualifications and in the project are admitted to the oral exam. During the oral test, aspects concerning the titles presented and the project will be deepened and clarified. The oral examination is considered passed if the candidate has obtained a score of 36/60.

The minimum total score for admission to the research doctorate is 72/120.
