

PHD IN EXPERIMENTAL AND CLINICAL HEPATOGASTROENTEROLOGY

SCORING CRITERIA – 39th CYCLE

In marking the candidates, the Commission will evaluate the following criteria individually and give an overall score that is an expression of the sum of the individual assessments.

Written Test

- Knowledge and competence on the topic of the test: up to 20 points
- Capacity of synthesize and clarity in carrying out the test: up to 20 points
- Descriptive completeness and updated knowledge regarding the subject of the test: up to 20 points.

The candidate must score at least 40/60 to pass the test.

Oral Test

- Debate on the topics of the specific PhD curricula: up to 40 points.
- Clarity of exposition, ability to summarize and appropriate scientific terminology: up to 10 points
- English language: up to 10 points.

The candidate must score at least 40/60 to pass the test.

The minimum overall score must be at least 80/120.
