

EVALUATION CRITERIA FOR THE ADMISSION TO THE PHD COURSE “PLANNING, DESIGN, ARCHITECTURE TECHNOLOGY” - PON (37TH CYCLE)

Qualifications to be validated may be sent as self-certifications, except

Required documents to be uploaded:

Documents that must be attached to the request for admission:

- 1) a Curriculum Vitae drafted in standard European format (obligatory);
- 2) an application letter explaining their motives (maximum 10,000 characters, including spaces) (obligatory);
- 3) when possible, a certificate attesting knowledge of Italian (hopefully at least at level B2, or higher) required only for foreign candidates, not required for native speakers;
- 4) when possible, a certificate attesting knowledge of English (hopefully at least at level B1, or higher);
- 5) any other certificates attesting a knowledge of other foreign languages.

The score assigned to candidates' qualifications will be distributed as follows:

1. THE ORAL EXAM (60 POINTS MAXIMUM):

The oral exam (60 points maximum) consists of the discussion on the content and methods of the written exam, the curriculum, and the knowledge of the English language. The oral exam will be considered accomplished with a minimum score of 40 out of 60 points.

3. ASSESSING A CANDIDATE'S QUALIFICATIONS AND APPLICATION LETTER (30 POINTS MAXIMUM):

The points awarded when assessing a candidate's qualifications will be distributed as follows:

- _ a maximum of 15 points for cover letters;
- _ a maximum of 15 points for the Curriculum Vitae, to be distributed as follows:

1) Final degree mark (master's degree, postgraduate diploma, integrated master's degree) (5 points maximum)

Students who have discussed the thesis after the closing of the application but before the evaluation of qualifications, must immediately after graduation deliver both the doctorate secretariat and the office of Dr. Marina Cocci (administrative secretary of the doctorate) the certificate of degree with final mark.

2) Experiences of participation in research groups (only institutional research with funding will be considered, carried out by institutions of accredited importance) (3 points maximum)

3) Study, postgraduate and postgraduate research experience, through scholarships, research grants, specialization courses (3 points maximum)

4) Workshop / stage experiences (only workshops / stages organized by Institutions of proven relevance will be considered). (2 points maximum)

5) Knowledge of foreign languages (2 points maximum)

Description	Points
Knowledge of English (and / or Italian, for foreigners) above the B1 level	1
Knowledge of another language, in addition to English, Italian and one's mother tongue, at least A2 level	1

FINAL IMPORTANT NOTES:

The maximum of 30 points of "Assessing a candidate's qualifications" will be added to the assessment of the oral exam (with a maximum score of 60 points, as mentioned earlier, but with a minimum threshold of 40 points), coming to a total score for the three assessments of 90 points maximum.

Candidates should be aware of the fact that the points awarded for each section of the admission process will only be published should a candidate pass the oral exam.
