4 - Research project (max 45 points)

For the purposes of selection for the PhD programme, the candidate must submit a project that can be used to assess his/her propensity for research and his/her ability to organise the various stages of the project (maximum length: 8000 characters -including spaces).

In particular, the following will be assessed

- Knowledge of the state of the art (10 points)
- Originality and innovative content (10 points)
- Clarity and completeness of the presentation of objectives, methodologies and potential results (10 points)
- Feasibility of the project (10 points)
- Relevance of the project to the PhD training objectives (5 points)

Candidates who have obtained at least 40 points in the overall assessment of qualifications will be admitted to the next round
