The paper describes the results of the filing of the files relating to the "Attacks on Bases (1940-1943)" fund preserved in the Archives of the Historical Office of the Navy. An ambitious work of technical and analytical filing, which allowed the inventorying and cataloging of the entire collection, following the rules of the Lucca school of archives.

The Thesis, in addition to representing a particularly rich and significant picture of what is preserved in the Fund in question, down to the level of the single document, is characterized by its extreme methodological rigor and clear and in-depth exposition, effectively creating an indispensable consultation tool for scholars and researchers and outlining an ideal inventory model as a reference for subsequent, possible, filing activities and, in particular, those relating to funds of the same Archive of the Historical Office of the Navy.
