dr. Salvatore Cannavò, born in Linguaglossa on 23 August 1964

Journalist and editor, currently deputy director of Fatto newspaper, former Deputy of the Republic in the 15th legislature, graduated in Political Science. In the field of journalism he is particularly involved in the digital sector. In 2003 he founded the publishing house Edizioni Alegre of which he is editorial director. In 2021 he was admitted to the PhD in Political Studies at the Department of Political Sciences of the La Sapienza University of Rome.

Deputy director with responsibility for digital content, he supervises the Economics and Foreign Affairs sectors and maintains relations with the administration, the editorial board and the legal department.

After twenty years of journalistic work, he assumes the managerial position and, responding to the managing director, coordinates the various company sectors, in particular Human Resources.

2010-2015, journalist at the daily newspaper

He begins to collaborate with Il Fatto Quotidiano dealing with economics and work. He was hired for an indefinite period in 2012. He later became head of the paid digital sector.

2006-2008, Member of Parliament of the Republic

From 2006 to 2008 he was elected to the Chamber of Deputies in the 15th legislature where he was part of the Defense Commission and actively participated in the political life of the legislature as can be seen in the national press. Political activity is strongly linked to the events of Italian social movements: he is one of the founders, in 2001, of the Attac Italia association, actively participates in the events of the World Social Forums and since 2003 he will be part of the International Council of the World Social Forum representing of the Project K.

1996-2009, deputy editor of the newspaper Liberazione

From 1996 to 2009 he was employed by the newspaper Liberazione where he was hired in 1996 and then became editor-in-chief in 1998 and deputy director in 2001. From 2004 he was appointed editorial director.

2003, he founds and directs the Alegre publishing house

Since 2003: he founded the publishing house Edizioni Alegre, of which he is editorial director. The publishing house boasts a series of prestigious collaborations and founded the Jacobin Italia magazine in 2018.
