This research project was commissioned by the Diocese of Rome and implemented in 2024. The research aims to analyze the identity construction and inclusion of "Second Generation" youth in the Roman community. Through focus groups and in-depth interviews, the relationship of young people with migrant backgrounds with their culture of origin and with Italian culture was examined to understand how they experience a cultural "double belonging." I was in charge of conducting the interviews and analyzing them. In addition, I participated in drafting the research report, writing section 5.3 "Il lavoro come esperienza di realtà".

Now, the projecting is still ongoing, and is expanding the research in the Lazio region.
