| Thesis Summary | <p>Neuperlach is currently the largest urban renewal research base in Munich. The renovation of this residential area is not only a challenge for urban development, but also provides a great possibility for urban development.</p> <p>This research is conducted through systematic thinking and path. As a project of urban block renewal, the research framework can be divided into the following four types of systems: Mobility system, Artificial and Sociological system, Bio-climate system, and Biophysical system.</p> <p>Through basic research, literature research, quantitative simulation, analytic hierarchy process and other methods, we found that the urban form designs affects urban microclimate and correspondingly outdoor thermal comfort as well by the provision of shading and ventilation to local areas. Then we combined with the characteristics of the urban renewal project and then proposed the strategy of urban block renewal based on microclimate optimization.</p> |
