Research project: **New fatherhood in Italy: from the gender issue to the family issue**. Gender literature in the economic and social domains has traditionally focused on women's difficulties in the working environment due to known constraints related to unpaid work (childcare and household chores), exacerbated by the COVID-19 health emergency. Traditionally, fathers have always remained on the family caring margins, either because they tend to be the first income earners and therefore devoted to career and work success or because they are forced by prejudice and discrimination not to contribute to unpaid work. Because of this social segregation in paid and unpaid work, gender policies remain focused on women and mothers, neglecting the involvement of men and fathers in achieving greater equality. In recent years, however, new forms of male parenting are also emerging in Italy, i.e., fathers who reject the male breadwinner stereotype and claim an active and equal role with mothers in family care. This study aims to explore the socio-demographics of the "new" fathers: it seeks to investigate their difficulties, resources and challenges in the work and social contexts, providing information and contributions to research on the reduction of gender inequalities in Italy.

By linking the male fertility of Generation Y or Millennials (fathers born between 1981 and 2000), the socio-economic characteristics of these fathers and their respective households, their access to family support measures, and their perception of gender stereotypes, the study also aims to compensate for the lack of data that take all these factors into account simultaneously, recognising the central (and not yet fully addressed) role of stereotypes towards men as one of the significant obstacles to gender equality inside and outside the family in Italy.
