The workshop is an FMOD initiative, a Research Group on the history of Early Modern and Modern philosophical and scientific thought, based at the University of Turin, Italy, in the Department of Philosophy and Education Sciences. There have long been two multi-year research projects: “Materialism and scientific naturalism in German 17th and 18th-century

philosophy”, and “Philosophers and philosophy outside the professional and academic field from the Early Modern to the Present time”, that had their start in 2013 and 2014 respectively. Currently, the FMOD group organizes annual workshop on the history of modern philosophy, with the participation of professors, researchers, MA students and from bachelor’s degree.

The workshop has two aims: 1. The lecture of Kant’s Religions within the Boundaries of Mere Reason and Fichte’s Attempt at a Critique of All Revelation; 2. The seminar discussion about these two works and their comparison.

Relevant works of the Kantforschung will also be taken in account.

Each meeting is organized as follows: two students present themes and arguments from a section of Kant's work and the relevant critical sources. Then, the activity envisages that professors and students discuss the report presented in the classroom in an atmosphere of interactive comparison.

The workshop has two aims: 1. To analyze and comprehend the content of Feuerbach’s work; 2. To discuss critically about Feuerbach’s contribution to a historical study of philosophy .

Relevant works of the Feuerbachforschung will also be taken in account. Especially, a meeting is dedicated to the exposition and discussion of a Friedrich Engel’s work about Feuerbach: Ludwig Feuerbach and the End of the Classical German Philosophy.

Each meeting is organized as follows: two students present themes and arguments from a section of Feuerbach’s work and the relevant critical sources. Then, the discussion begins.
